# **INTERVIEW WITH CERAMICIST EMMA PRZGRODZKA**

## **1. Emma what got you into ceramics in the first place?**

I studied a BA (Hons) in Three Dimensional Design at Bath, focusing on 2D graphics after graduating. I returned to ceramics four years ago, drawn back to the mindful and meditative practice of working with clay.

## **2. How do you find inspiration for your next pieces?**

After a recent trip to Japan, I have been deeply influenced by Japanese ceramic art, wood firing, and the Kurinuki technique. Inspired by the tradition and variety of incredible textures and glazes, as well as the philosophy of Wabi-Sabi, I intentionally incorporate asymmetry and the beauty of imperfection into my work. I aim to find beauty in everyday objects, blending both traditional and modern techniques to create something unique.

## **3. The colours are quite muted is there a reason behind your colour palette?**

My colour palette is focused on organic forms and the landscape. I aim to replicate this palette by layering my work with oxides and simple glazes. Using an electric, wood, or raku kiln makes each firing unpredictable and each piece unique.

Don't let a lack of facilities hold you back, you can hand-build from home and even fire your creations in your microwave! (though can't promise they won't blow up;)

Building a soda kiln with the DCPG at the Chiltern Open Air Museum.

Learning to throw Korean moonjars over the summer in Italy

I am interested in pursuing community projects, collaborations and commissions.



# Butterflies in Ballgowns



## How did you get into your designs and outfits?

I have always loved clothing, and from a young age I wanted to be a fashion designer. However, as I grew up I started to realise the awful impact that the fashion industry has on the planet, because of this, it didn't feel like a dream I could follow as it didn't fit with my morals or values. Instead, I followed my other passions of travel and helping others and moved to Canada and started working in Social Work - working in a homeless shelter and also with adults with developmental disabilities. Unfortunately after 3 years I had to leave my job, as I was diagnosed with PTSD and was suffering with burnout.

After meeting with my therapist, I finally decided that I owed it to myself to follow my dreams and passions and I decided to enrol in the Textiles course at the local Arts College. I absolutely loved the course and it inspired me to continue pursuing what I love, so I launched my only clothing company. In keeping with my morals and values, everything I sell is handmade by myself using second hand and upcycled fabric.

## Where does your inspiration come from?

The natural world is one of main inspirations, and it also has a huge impact on the resources I use as a designer and maker. I keep the health of the earth at the forefront of my mind when choosing the fabrics, yarns and dyes that I work with. All the materials that I use are either thrifted, upcycled or organic and sustainably sourced, helping to reduce **Butterflies in Ballgowns** impact on the planet.

## Do you have an arts background?

Yes - I have always loved art in all forms. I suffer from anxiety, so it has always been a go-to tool to help with my mental health. My Mum and Grandma are also very creative and very talented seamstresses, so it's always been something we have shared and been able to do together which is amazing and very inspiring.


# Alessia

Putting the finishing touches to my first ever spoon I managed to sever the tendons on my index finger resulting in reconstructive surgery, six months of physio and a burgeoning addiction to spoon carving.

From spoon carving the next logical step was woodturning and so I managed to get a lathe into my shed and the rest is history. I fell in love with discovering shapes in logs and the more I learn the more I realise I have to learn.

What makes my products different, I believe, is that I like to pass the story of the tree along to the customer, for every piece I will not only know the wood type but also where the tree stood, why it came down and more wonderful idiosyncrasies particular to that species of tree.

All my wood is local and sustainable and my operation is carbon neutral.

Her 'Seascape' and unique 'Life' collections have been her most popular collections to date. Artworks with titles inspired by Skevi's feelings, world events or simply wanting to portray a positive message. Her work has evolved over time and the layering, depth and detail on each piece is something that is not achievable by traditional painting methods using acrylic or oils.

Skevi has successfully exhibited internationally and had a successful first solo exhibition at Molasses House Gallery last summer. Her artwork decorates homes, offices and hotels in numerous countries across the globe and her work has been featured in Tatler and The World of Interiors magazines. Skevi has been a finalist for the Art Unlimited Open Art Competition 2022 and longlisted for the VAA Art Prize 2022, 2023 & 2024.
